

IV. UNDERSTAND ONCE SAVED YOU ARE ALWAYS SAVED (10:28-30)

“28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father’s hand.

30 I and My Father are one.” John 10:28-30

- Christians are kept saved by the **power** of God.

“3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

4 to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,

5 who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.”

I Peter 1:3-5

“35 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

36 As it is written: “For Your sake we are killed all day long;

We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.”

37 Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.

38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come,

39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.” Romans 8:35-39

JESUS GIVES SECURITY

I. KNOW JESUS IS THE **GOOD** SHEPHERD (10:11-14)

“11 *“I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.*

12 *But a hireling, he who is not the shepherd, one who does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and flees; and the wolf catches the sheep and scatters them.*

13 *The hireling flees because he is a hireling and does not care about the sheep.*

14 *I am the good shepherd; and I know My sheep, and am known by My own.”* John 10:11-14

- Jesus **died** for the sheep (vs 11-13).

“24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

25 *For you were like sheep going astray, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.”*

I Peter 2:24-25

- Jesus **knows** His sheep (v14).

“6 *“Are not five sparrows sold for two copper coins? And not one of them is forgotten before God.*

7 *But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.”*

Luke 12:6-7

II. BELIEVE IN JESUS AS THE **CHRIST** (10:24-26)

“24 *Then the Jews surrounded Him and said to Him, “How long do You keep us in doubt? If You are the Christ, tell us plainly.”*

25 *Jesus answered them, “I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father’s name, they bear witness of Me.”* John 10:24-25

- **Rejecting** Jesus leads to judgment and hell.

“He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him—the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.” John 12:48

- **Receiving** Jesus leads to life and heaven.

“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.” John 5:24

III. **LISTEN** TO AND **FOLLOW** JESUS (10:27)

“My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.” John 10:27

- It is a **sign** of a true believer.

“21 *“Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.*

22 *Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’*

23 *And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’”*

Matthew 7:21-23

- It is a **source** of a tremendous blessing.
